A meeting of the Board of Directors (BOD) of the Orange County (OC) Post of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) was held at the offices of Ninyo and Moore on Monday, 13 September 2010. Mr. Davis, the SAME OC Post President, called the meeting to order at noon.

1. Minutes Review

Draft minutes from the August 2010 BOD meeting were reviewed. The minutes were approved with no modifications.

2. Treasurer's Report

Ms. Cornwall presented the monthly Treasurer's Report for review by the BOD. Ms. Cornwall reported that the check to the SAME/SD Post in the amount of ½ of the total from Camp Pendleton Day net proceeds has been delivered.

Discussion was held regarding liability insurance coverage for the BOD. It has been determined that National has a general liability insurance policy. Ms. Cornwall recommends that we obtain a policy for the OC Post

3. Program Committee Report

General discussion. Mr. Davis reported that everything went well at the event.
Sue Pender to follow up with SMPS on proceeds from the event.

- o <u>Friday, 10 September: Golf Tournament:</u> Mr. Davis reported that the event was a success. There were over 80 attendees. Proceeds from the event went to the Disabled Veterans Program. The Board agreed that the veterans should participate in the event next year.
- O Thursday, 7 October Scholarship Lunch Meeting. Mr. Davis reported that plans were proceeding. He stated that he had confirmed that members of the Miles family would attend. Colonel Klein, ACOE inter-Agency Lead for VA Programs is the confirmed speaker. All scholarship winners have been identified. Four SAME winners and 1 Tom Miles scholarship will be presented at the October meeting. Karen Miles will be presenting the Tom Miles Scholarship.
- <u>Tuesday, November 2 Annual Symposium.</u> Mr. Carter described current plans to have 3-4 topical segments, each with 2-3 speakers addressing the topics. Colonel Mark Toy, Robert Kirkbright and John Coon have been confirmed. Segment topic/speaker suggestions were solicited, including Navy/Air Force/Army topics and representatives, Business Opportunities, Disaster/Emergency Response, NASA/CA Space. The business symposium committee will begin weekly conference calls starting Friday, September 17. Discussion regarding which charities should be present and receive donations was held. The Cancer Society and Wounded Warriors were selected as the charities which will be receiving donations. Amount of donations will be determined at a later date.

<u>Scholarships</u> – Mr. Davis reported that 10 general applications have been submitted, in addition to several Miles Scholarship applications. Mr. Everly reported that the Miles family was adding \$500 to the Scholarship.

<u>LA Post School Outreach Program</u> – Mr. Pringle provided an update on his discussions with the Program representatives and his research into the program. He reported that he was denied permission to contact each school (as was his direction from the last BOD meeting). He and Mr. Davis had communicated and, based on the prior BOD discussions, they selected Sunrise Elementary School to sponsor. He reported that the Program representatives would contact us for the next step. Our involvement may be as basic as assisting with contest judging and providing speakers. Mr. Pringle held a discussion for creating our own program in Orange County.
